King's will be competing in races in both the S3 Category (Yrs. 10-12) and S2 Category (Years 6-9) of the Australian Human Powered Super Series (AHPVSS) Pedal Prix Competition.

What is Pedal Prix?

Pedal Prix involves teams of student who participate in a series of organised races in three wheeled HPVs (Human Powered Vehicles) around tracks at various locations including Victoria Park, The Bend Raceway & Murray Bridge. The duration of races range from 6–24 hours in length. The AHPVSS is the largest event of its type in the World.

What are the benefits of King's being involved with Pedal Prix?

Being involved in Pedal Prix provides students with a host of learning opportunities with real-world links. This includes, but is not limited to, Enterprise & Entrepreneurism, Racing & Engineering, Design and Technology, Physics, Mathematics, Information Technology, Health & Nutrition, Catering, Fitness, Sustainability, and the Environment.

Our students gain an enormous sense of satisfaction by being involved in Pedal Prix and learn a great deal about fitness, teamwork, competition, safety, and vehicle control. The Kings Racing (Pedal Prix) Team is a great community where strong relationships develop around shared interests and goals.

While it is hard work, students find it incredibly rewarding from both a personal development and teamwork perspective, and most importantly, they have a great time doing it!

How are students involved with Pedal Prix?

- **Riding Team**

The Riding teams, include students from Years 6 -12 will be selected according to fitness testing and driving ability.

- **Support Crew**

Students can also be involved in a variety of areas including but not limited to, Pit Crew which involves vehicle maintenance and repair (on and off Track) and ensuring fast rider changeovers. 'Data and Analysis' monitoring rider and vehicle performance & Graphic Design & Marketing looking after video and photography and media releases relating to Pedal prix.

- **SACE Stage 1 course**

There is a SACE Stage 1 course offered to Year 10 students whom would like to develop engineering skills. This class will be trained in all aspects of HPV vehicle development and maintenance with the intention of being suitable as support crew and riders for racing events.

Pedal Prix has roles to cater for almost everyone's personal interest as well as developing a strong sense of community as people bring complimentary skills to achieve a team outcome.


